Bhiwandi, Feb 13 : Bhiwandi city is supplied with 73 D.L.L. from the STEM Authority, 42 D.L.L. from the Brihanmumbai Municipal Corporation and 5 D.L.L. from the Municipal Corporation's own Varhala Lake, totaling 120 D.L.L. per day, from which 90 D.L.L. per day sewage is being generated. At present, a

sewage treatment plant with a capacity of 43 D.L.L. is operational and 30 D.L.L. sewage generated in the city is being processed. A total of 7 pumping stations and 4 sewage treatment plants have been constructed under the Bhiwandi Nizampur City Municipal Corporation's underground sewerage scheme phase-2 project.

The TRIAL RUN of the said pumping stations and sewage treatment plants is underway. After the said pumping stations and sewage treatment plants are fully operational, the total capacity of processing sewage generated from the city will be 112 D.L.L. per day. The sewage generated from the city will be fully processed.

ASI arrested by ACB in corruption case

Srinagar, Feb 13 (UNI) Jammu and Kashmir's Anti-Corruption Bureau (ACB) on Friday arrested an Assistant Sub-Inspector of Police in Srinagar for allegedly demanding and accepting a bribe of Rs 8,000.

According to ACB, they received a written complaint alleging that Mukhtar Ahmad Khan, Assistant Sub-Inspector of Police Station Bemina, Srinagar and the Investigating Officer of an FIR demanded illegal gratification from the complainant despite the case already having been challaned before a competent court. He allegedly threatened harassment if the demand was not met. Following discreet verification that prima facie confirmed the allegations, the ACB registered FIR No. 04/2026 under Section 7 of the Prevention of Corruption Act, 1988, at ACB Police Station Srinagar.

Abhishek visits slain Purulia migrant worker's home, demands stringent punishment for culprits

Kolkata, Feb 13 (UNI) West Bengal's ruling Trinamool Congress National General Secretary Abhishek Banerjee on Friday urged all political parties to come forward and protest against the alleged brutal murder of a migrant worker from Purulia Sukhen Mahato in Maharashtra.

"The BJP is busy stopping our dues. I call upon Jyotirmoy Singh Mahato, BJP MP from Purulia, to call up the Chief Minister of Maharashtra and urge him to ensure that the criminals involved with the murder are arrested and exemplary punishment is given," Banerjee said after meeting the family members of the ill-fated worker in Purulia.

He said a Trinamool Congress delegation, along with Mahato's relatives, will go to Maharashtra towards the end of this month if the criminals are not arrested.

"I am told that one person has been arrested. More people should be arrested, and the trial should start. We will have to ensure the miscreants do not get bail and we will go to the highest court of law in the country to give them punishment. I have assured Sukhen's parents that we will provide every possible legal assistance to punish the miscreants," he said.

Banerjee said he will urge state Chief Minister Mamata Banerjee to help Sukhen's two brothers get jobs in Purulia, as they do not want to go back to

Maharashtra. "Since 2009, the deceased and his two brothers had been working in the same company in Pune. Sukhen's elder brother told me that the slain youth used to work in the 3.30 pm to 11.30 pm shift. On the fateful day, his elder brother, who had been staying in Maharashtra from 2009, had called him up," said Banerjee.

But he could not get in touch with Sukhen as his phone was switched off. He had called him up several times but could not get through.

The next morning, the police called up to inform him that Sukhen had received injuries. He went to the hospital and found that he was dead. "A

video footage has shown how brutally he was killed. I do not want to do politics over death, but the police should find out what had prompted the miscreants to kill him," he said. Coming down heavily on the BJP, he said, "It is alarming that in the past few months, Bengali-speaking migrant workers have been killed in the BJP-ruled states. The pattern has worried all of us. This cannot go on. The miscreants should be arrested and punished."

"In the BJP-ruled states, the rapists, extortionists and murderers are arrested and given bail. We will not allow this to happen. We will go to the highest level to see that the miscreants are given stringent punishment," he added.

Meghalaya coal mine blast: 'Dead' man turns out to be alive

Shillong, Feb 13 (UNI) In an apparent case of medical mis-judgement related to the dynamic blast at the Myngnat-Thangso coal mine in Meghalaya's East Jaintia Hills, an injured man who was declared dead was later found to be alive to the respite of his family.

Family members of the 44-year-old Shyambabu Singha had performed his last rites, believing he had been succumbed to his injuries in the February 5 dynamite explosion.

However, Singha's family members later discovered that he had mistakenly taken the body of another victim to their native place in Karimganj, Assam.

"Singha was reportedly taken to the North Eastern India Gandhi Regional Institute of Health and Medical Sciences (NEIGRIHMS) after the blast and was said to have died on February 8. His body was then handed over to his family,"

Kumar, the district magistrate of East Jaintia Hills, said.

"However, on February 12, the district administration received information that Shyambabu Singha was still alive," Kumar said.

Upon verification over the phone, the district magistrate said, it was confirmed that the family had mistakenly claimed the body of another deceased person and had already conducted the funeral rites.

The belongings of the deceased, however, remain with Shyambabu's family. Kumar said investigation is on to determine the identity of the person whose body was mistakenly claimed and cremated by Shyambabu's family.
